The funds would be used to partially fund the salaries of the positions that provide the technical assistance on projects, encourage participation in projects/programs through outreach, and administer the grant funds.

Improvement projects are typically done by rural County residents, so they are directly benefitted. Water quality improvements also benefit City and Town residents who use and/or recreate in these waters. SCCD also applies for local funding support through the City of Sheridan, the Towns of Dayton, Ranchester, and Clearmont, and local residents through a membership program..
